### *Cost*

This camp costs only \$25 per child. For families with more than one child attending, cost is \$20 each. Please make checks out to Living Hope Ministries. Children will not be able to come without payment.

### *Facilities and Accommodations*

Luther Park is 186 wooded acres, including a private bay with just under one mile of shoreline on northwest shore of Lake 26. Located seven miles east of Danbury, Wisconsin, the camp is within a two-hour drive of the Twin Cities metro area. With a beach, boats, craft cabin, sports field, and ropes course, there is no shortage of fun! Kids will sleep in the bunkbeds in cabins. An average cabin will have about 2 counselors and 8 kids.

## *What to Bring*

### **Items**

Bible, casual clothes, swimsuit, sweater or jacket, rainwear, sleeping bag/bedding, two pair of shoes, one dress-up outfit, insect repellent, flashlight, pillow, towels, washcloth, toiletries, notebook, pen, camera, musical instrument (guitar, harmonica, etc.), spending money (items may be purchased in the canteen). Please label all items and leave valuables at home.

### **Spending Money**

All money will be deposited in a canteen account on arrival to prevent loss.

- Arts & crafts projects range from no charge to \$15.
- Clothes range from \$11 to \$35.
- Snacks, if desired, cost \$5 to \$20 for the week.
- Money left over at the end of the week is returned to the camper or may be left as an offering. The offering would go to our new Camper to Camper Fund, which would be used to help kids come to camp who otherwise couldn't afford to attend.

### **Please do not bring:**

Radios, tape/cd players, electronic games, phones, pagers, fireworks, firearms, knives, expensive jewelry. Camp policy forbids having/using alcohol, tobacco, or mood altering drugs.

## *Luther Park Camp Code of Conduct*

**\*Please read this code of conduct with your child. By signing the registration form, you agree to follow this code. If a child fails to follow this code, a parent or guardian will be expected to take the camper home.**

1. Respect other people and their property. Respect is the most important tradition we have at Luther Park. We expect that you respect yourself, others and their property, Luther Park staff, nature and God. A part of respect is treating others as you would want to be treated. The following will not be allowed: racist comments, teasing, fighting, threats, swearing, and any other behavior that is demeaning to another person. We want a positive week for all who attend camp.
2. Safety is our number one concern at all times. Obeying all waterfront rules when: swimming, boating, canoeing and fishing allows everyone to have fun in the sun. Waterfront activities are available only when waterfront staff is on duty.
3. Campers must be accompanied by a Luther Park staff person whenever outside of camp property.
4. We are pleased to offer an alcohol-free, smoke-free and substance abuse-free environment. Exceptions must be approved by the director.
5. Luther Park is a weapon-free environment. Campers may not bring any kind of weapon or explosive device, including firecrackers to camp. Use of any object as a weapon to hurt a person, animal or property will not be tolerated.
6. Luther Park reserves the right to store camper's personal items that may be inappropriate to their stay. Items will be returned for the trip home upon permission of the parent(s).
7. For your protection, all medications (including non-prescription pain relievers) must be turned into the camp health supervisor. If you are injured or do not feel well, report at once to your counselor or health supervisor. This is important for your safety and for the good of all campers.
8. Every camper is expected to follow the entire camp schedule unless excused by the program director.
9. To assure the safety of each camper and to provide the best week possible, campers are expected to follow all Luther Park rules that are presented to them while at camp.
